

How many people?

<p>Preparation Duplicate enough pages for each student to have one card.</p>

- As students are working, walk around to monitor the activity and help as needed. Make sure students are counting the affirmative answers. Encourage students to add extra information to their answers. Make note of any errors or problems to review later.
- To wrap up the activity, ask a few students to report the results of their surveys to the class by reading a question and saying how many yes answers they received. Ask students why they would or would not like to do certain things.

Procedure

- Tell students they are going to walk around the classroom and ask each other questions about things they would like to do. Write on the board the question *How many people would like to learn to ski?* Then ask students what question they would ask classmates to find out if they would like to learn to ski. (*Would you like to learn to ski?*) Elicit answers from students. They should answer the questions with *Yes, I would.* or *No, I wouldn't.*
- Distribute one card to each student. Students should read the questions on their cards and then complete the third question with their own idea. When everyone has finished writing their own question, ask the class to stand up and walk around, talking to as many people as possible in 15 minutes. Tell them to record the number of yes answers to see how many people really would like to do that thing.
